### **MEASURING IMPACT:**

Our chosen area of focus will be Northumberland ASL modular PESS CPD programme using impact info gathered to demonstrate impact on adult learning.

**3.SUCCESS STORIES:** LOTS OF GREAT STUFF GOING ON – **Actions;** Can SSCos continue to prompt /gather impact success stories linked to their work in schools etc? Barndale school to submit Impact of Activate success story ASAP (JD to support) .

**1.SECONDARY HoDs PE UPDATE MEETING** (Sept 28<sup>th</sup>): Failed to run due to low responses -despite SSP support and various promotional info to schools! Any thoughts / Actions?

**2.KS3 PE CURRIC DEV -YOUR LEADERS KS3 RESOURCE DISSEMINATION AND PILOT:** Successful half-day event on 30th Sept. Thanks to Franki Clarke for supporting delivery after Liz had to withdraw (illness in family). 17 staff attended event – good support from nominated SSCos. 9 schools (mainly middle and 2 highs represented) Tweed mouth & Ponteland did not attend. 5 action plans received on time. Still awaiting action plans for roll out /pilot from: Cramlington Learning Village (Deb Chappell attended); Seahouses MS (Julie Harris and Nicola Johnson); Richard Coates MS (Jill Ash & teacher ..... )Blyth School (Carol Ward) **Action:** AB to contact SSCos to prompt their schools to submit. SSCos to chase please. Sharing *progress + developments* meeting planned for Jan 21<sup>st</sup> – Hepscott Pk. Schools to share progress and present success stories by May 1<sup>st</sup> Pilot schools to support next phase roll out– possibly on an SSP dev day ?

**3. AfPE SAFE PRACTICE IN PESS WORKSHOPS (PRIMARY /SECONDARY)** Glen Beaumont (AfPE health & Safety officer) .32 attending AM session 28 schools represented .12 at PM workshop (ref aggregated evaluations circulated earlier this month – AM delivery a little disappointing PM much better). **Action**s – Peter Flynn e-mailing /writing to schools to clarify and confirm acceptable extra curricular sports fixtures /events supervisory recommendations. Can PDMs & SSCos continue to signpost / reference /promote Safe Practice in PESS publication in schls.

**4.NQT CPD PROGRAMME:** Introductory module – planning & teaching HQ PE 4<sup>th</sup> Nov (AW & AB) .15 attending -1 additional non-NQT turning up (sent by H/T /SSCo!). Very successful day. Next module Gymnastics 26<sup>th</sup> Nov, Helen, Andy and Jane Errington planning & delivering. **Actions;** NQTs to register via Carol Martin (County Hall); Paul Gaines & Andy Blight to consider attending /observing delivery - to assist in planning & delivery of HQ Games module

**5.SAQ & CORE TASKS DVD WORKSHOPS** (Morpeth Ponteland SSP) –6<sup>th</sup> Nov. 11 & 6 attending respectively. Both workshops and HQ resources well received. New core tasks resource and accompanying CPD – over 135 staff have attended CPD / received this HQ resource. **IS it being used in your schools to help staff plan, teach and improve progress** – HQ PE ? **Actions:** AB to circulate spreadsheet showing which schools have attended /received. Can PDMs and SSCos chase schools yet to attend /receive CPD and new resource and consider what next for these schools in their partnership.
